I have undertaken interpretive project planning, research and copywriting for a host of cultural and natural heritage initiatives, including visitor centres, museums, historic buildings and churches, and delivered engaging interpretation for gardens, towns, forests, seashores and geological sites.

I offer interpretive and heritage planning training and mentoring for heritage sites and museums, helping organisations, community groups and volunteers develop their heritage skills and build their confidence and capacity. I also spent ten years as visiting lecturer on evaluating interpretation for the University of Lincoln's Museum & Exhibition Design course. I am a longstanding full member and former committee member of the Association for Heritage Interpretation, and am part of the team delivering the biennial AHI Discover Heritage awards.
